The Electoral Politics of Extreme Policies

A government may adopt extreme policies (policies which are distant from the ideal points of both the decisive voter and of the ruling party) for electoral purposes. The incentive to do so appears when a change in policy is costly, and when the opposing party cannot commit to maintaining the status quo.
